Fall 2025 Updates: MCAS Portal and Student Kiosk

- MCAS Portal Updates
 - Batch printing testing tickets
 - Student progress view
 - New users will only receive one email with their username and a link to set their password.
- MCAS Student Kiosk Updates
 - Answer eliminator is no longer available
- Updated MCAS Student Kiosk now available for download

Fall 2025 Updates: November Retest Policies

- Prescribed windows with recommended dates for high school tests
- Students may not earn the Competency Determination (CD) through participation in the November 2025 retests.
 - DESE is continuing to offer the November retests to students attempting to qualify for scholarships and/or the Seal of Biliteracy.

Note: New for 2025–26, high school tests will be conducted within allowable windows, and DESE is providing recommended dates instead of prescribed dates.

2. Student Registration



November Retest Student Registration Deadlines

- Initial Student Registration Window: September 15–26
 - Important in order to receive manuals for CBT and PBT, and PBT materials and student labels
- Extended pre-administration student registration window for CBT:
 September 29–November 4
 - Schools will not receive an automatic shipment of PBT materials or manuals for students registered after September 26; schools will need to manually place an additional materials order through the <u>MCAS Service Center website</u>.

November Retest Participation FAQ

Q: Are grade 11 and 12 students required to participate in the November 2025 retests if they have not yet participated in ELA and/or Mathematics MCAS testing?

A: No. Students are not required to participate, and students may not earn the <u>Competency Determination</u> through participation in the retests.

• Students in grades 11 and 12 are eligible to participate if they would like to qualify for the <u>Adams Scholarship</u>, the <u>Koplik Certificate of Mastery</u>, and the <u>Seal of Biliteracy</u> (these are the *only purposes for participation*).

Q: Can grade 11 and 12 students participate in the spring 2026 grade 10 ELA and Math tests instead of November Retest?

A: Students in grade 11 or 12 who were reported as grade 9 students in the prior school year **are required to participate** in spring 2026 grade 10 ELA and Mathematics testing for accountability purposes. All other grades 11 and 12 students are not required to participate in spring 2026.

- Students in grade 11 are **eligible** to participate in the spring grade 10 ELA and Mathematics tests if they are attempting to qualify for scholarship purposes. Students in grades 11 and 12 are **eligible** to participate in the spring grade 10 ELA test for the Seal of Biliteracy.
- Students in grade 12 are **not eligible to participate** in spring grade 10 tests for scholarship purposes.
- Additional details will be provided in spring grade 10 MCAS participation guidelines which will be posted soon.


